Your Cradley & Storridge Lengthman and P3 Team have had another busy month.

We are trying to take advantage of summer weather conditions to complete several jobs best suited to the time of year . Rain has been a small problem and Rob has put in some extra hours to progress our painting works when dry conditions prevail . Kingsbridge repainting is programmed for September [Wx permitting] .

We will soon need to return to tidied- up areas to strim and generally maintain previously sorted areas. This will be an ongoing feature of our work as more and more areas are improved to our standards of care.

As autumn closes in we hope to give more attention to preparations for winter conditions. This will include giving attention to gulleys, grips, culverts and drains in addition to salt bin management.

The recent storms necessitated your Cradley Team to attend to a serious collapse of a large Ash tree which totally blocked the Brookside to Poundbridge road.
