Monthly Report : October 2015

Dear Councillors,

Another busy month for your Lengthman /P3 Team with a 5-Friday month of work completed . After plenty of hassle, I took Rob to Bedworth, Warks for our NRWSA - Unit-002 course. This certificate [ if we passed .. results awaited ] covers Signage , Guarding and Lighting Street Works and means we will be fully qualified to carry out CAT 2 Pothole repairs to C roads and minor roads [ Not A & B class Roads ] .

Materials for pothole work have been ordered from B-B and we collected them all in readiness for a November start.

[ nb All P3 & Lengthman Materials are stored at Chapel Court under my supervision . ] Works at St Katherine's passage way are now almost complete. One more day should finish the job. This month, two of our days have been devoted to Footpath R & M work. We have achieved a lot including the erection of new stiles, several new signposts, path repairs, vegetation clearance and disposal of all branch materials around Brookside, Poundbridge and most of St Katherines. We hope to start getting ready for winter from November and still hope for a good weather window to paint Kingsbridge. After 5 months work I can report that our budget forecast is holding up well. Leaf-fall debris, etc will be tackled after the very slow fall has finished as will grip cutting and gulley clearances.
