The Parish Council has spent over four years consulting and listening to the community in order to produce a document that has successfully been through all the checks and balances required by local and and central government

How does the NDP help my community?

It provides local Planning guidance that HCC HAVE to consider in relation to planning applications that affect the Parish

Example: Pixiefields

The Planners had to take into account the NDP policies defined for Cradley, and this was influential in their rejection of the proposed design and layout of the scheme

With the NDP in place ALL future plans will be required to comply with YOUR community's NDP

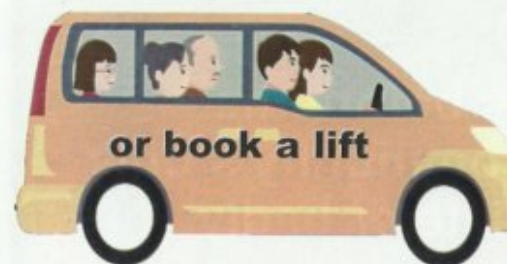
